LINCOLNSHIRE TRACK AND FIELD LEAGUE

Boston and District Athletic Club members increased their number of successes at the second Lincolnshire Track and Field match at Grantham last weekend. Representatives amassed thirty three wins, twenty one seconds and seventeen third places in good weather conditions at the South Kesteven Stadium.

Nathan McClure achieved a treble with wins in the Under 15 Boys 100 metres recording 12.6 secs., High Jump with a leap of 1.50m. and Long Jump with a clearance of 4.82m.. At Under 20 Mens level Stephan Brockett gained four first places in a range of track and field events. On the track Stephan won the 200 metres sprint in 24.8 secs., in the field the Long Jump with 5.72m., Pole Vault with an impressive clearance of 3.60m and Shot with a putt measured at 8.75m.. He also contributed to the Boston and District A.C. victory in the Under 20 Mens 4 x 400m. Relay event with the winning quartet clocking 3 mins. 55.5 secs.. In the Senior Mens category Stuart Smith won three of the eight events he competed in. A Discus throw of 35.06m. prevailed and in the Shot a putt of 10.51m. also contributed winners points and a 400 metres run in a time of 59.6 secs, gave Stuart his third victory. In the Under 20 Womens section Isabelle Whitehead won the 400m. Hurdles 72.0 secs. and the 200 metres 29.9 secs. and in the field took maximum points in Triple Jump 9.17m. and in her first competition of the season Emily Richardson won both High Jump 1.40m. and Javelin with an impressive first 2009 mark of 30.52m. Senior Hammer thrower Wayne Clarke threw 51.17m to win that contest and on the track Robert Richards secured a good victory over 800 metres recording 2 mins. 12 secs. In the Veteran Mens category Karl Wright won the 400m. Hurdles (72.1 secs) and George Ashcroft was first in the Long Jump (4.85m.). Under 17 Chelsea Brockett recorded 48.3 secs to cross the line first in the 300m. Hurdles and also won the 800 metres in 2 mins, 29 secs. before playing her part in the "Gold Tops" 4 x 200m. Relay victory in 1 min. 58.7 secs.. Four Under 17 Men finished on top in their respective events . Marc Bradbury advanced his performance level in Shot recording 10.76m, just 2cm, further than runner up and team mate Haden Brittain who in turn won the Hammer with a very promising 44.42m.. Marc also won the Discus contest recording 32.08m. and Jeremy Baily took first place in the Triple Jump with a clearance of 11.28m. A leap of 1.63m. earned Aiden McClure victory in the High Jump. At Under 15 Boys level Chris Corbett had a good win in the Triple Jump with a leap of 10.02m. and the BADAC 4 x 200m. Relay 'A' team came home first clocking 1 min. 49.4 secs.. In the Under 13 Boys Hammer contest Luke MacLoud threw 12.93m. for his first position.

Second positions were achieved by Ellie Boyson in the Under 15 Girls 1500 metres 5 mins 26.2 secs. and Louise Rutt over 800 metres 2 mins. 35.2 secs. giving BADAC a valuable one- two in the Under 17 age group and Melanie Bristow claimed the same place in Javelin with 26.70m.. On his club debut Under 11 Ashley Berg gained a pair of encouraging second places in Ball Throw 30.20m. and Long Jump 2.92m. and at Under 15 level Sam Johnson claimed a pair of seconds in 800 metres recording 2mins. 27 .1 secs. and High Jump with a clearance of 1.35m. and Chris Corbett added a second to his tally with 4.52m. in Long Jump. Jeremy Baily was second over the line in the Under 17 Mens 800 metres recording 2 mins. 14.7 secs. and Haden Brittain was runner up in Javelin with a promising 36.52m..Under 20 Stephan Brockett finished runner up in the 100 metres in 12.6 secs. and in the same age group Jake Brittain claimed second place points in both Long Jump 4.86m. and Pole Vault 3.40m.. In addition to his string of firsts Stuart Smith claimed seconds in Senior Mens Long Jump 5.28m. , Triple Jump 10.44m. and Hammer 30.25m.. and Veteran George Ashcroft finished second in the 100 metres 13.4 secs.. In the "Vet. Mens" 1500 metres Edgar Jokolovskis recorded 4 mins. 46.7 secs for second and Karl Wright achieved the same position in the Javelin with a throw of 30.90m..

Third positions went to Maria Hollingsworth High Jump 1.35m. and the Under 15 Girls 4x200m. Relay quartet 2 mins. 02.0 secs. At Under 17 level Wednesday Pywowariw recorded 51.2 secs. for third in the 300m. Hurdles race and 4.01m. in Long Jump and Louise Rutt finished in the same position in in the flat 300m. in 46.8 secs.. before Melanie Bristow added third place points in Discus. In the Under 15 Boys category Chris Corbett ran a good third in the 200 metres (28.4 secs.) and Michael Craven claimed the same position in the 1500 metres (4 mins. 59.2 secs.) and Sam Johnson added value in Triple Jump (9.67m.) and Anthony Sandall's putt of 7.30m. earned him third place in Shot and the "B" 4 x 200m. Relay team was third past the post. Under 17 Aiden McClure recorded 4 mins. 50.4secs. in third in the 1500 metres and Marc Bradbury added a third to his haul for the day with a 36.52m. Javelin throw.In the Senior Javelin contest Stuart Smith contributed further third place points to the BADAC total in Javelin 28.75m. and Veterans Geoge Ashcroft 200 metres (27.7 secs) and Peter Flint 1500m. Steeplechase (6 mins. 49.4 secs.) added value in their section. There were additional good performances from Alice Flint, Becky Locking, Emma Pennistone, Oliver Smith, Adam Bevan and George Proctor who all contributed valuable points to the "Gold Tops" team total.
