In addition to the successes of Dominic Sykes (Boston Grammar) Bronze medalist in the Junior Boys Hammer and Sarah Stanhope (Giles) sixth in the Intermediate Girls Hammer a number of Lincolnshire representatives at the English Schools Athletic Association Track and Field Championships performed well. Amongst the local contingent Alex. Pycock (Boston Grammar) picked up an injury and missed out on the heats of the Intermediate Boys 200 metres sprint Championship. From the same school on his first ESAA Championship appearance Nathan McClure cleared a personal best 3.05m. in the Junior Boys Pole Vault to claim a very respectable eighth place. Stephanie Hendy (Spalding High) achieved 39.35m. in the Intermediate Girls Hammer event to finish in the top half of the results list in eighth position and from the same school Charlotte Taylor recorded 10 mins. 06.94 secs. crossing the line ninth at the end of the Inter. Girls 3,000 metres. At the 2009 Championships at Sheffield which uniquely included a local representative in the Hammer in all of the five age groups which include the throw in the programme Sean Band (Boston College) was thirteenth in the Senior Boys event with 47.10m. and Haden Brittain (Thomas Cowley High School) in his first appearance at the ESAA Champs. recorded 44.76m. for twenty first position in the Intermediate Boys competition.
