

NORTH MIDLANDS CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE AT CORBY.

Eleven Boston and District A.C. distance runners braved the wet and windy conditions to compete in the North Midlands Cross Country League match at Corby on Saturday. The slippery muddy underfoot conditions at the West Glebe Park coupled with the poor weather made the events particularly challenging for the "Gold Tops". The best team performance was in the Under 17 Womens category with Chelsea Brockett in fourteenth position followed by Louise Rutt twentieth and Emma Penniston twenty fifth recording a solid team performance. In the Under 17 Mens event Aidan McClure led in the counting trio crossing the finish line in twenty second place. Jeremy Baily was second counter in twenty eighth position ahead of Luke Chester who claimed twenty fifth place. Running solo Alice Flint entered the funnel in twenty eighth position in the Under 15 Girls challenge. Three contestants in the Senior / Veteran Mens race achieved positions showing improvements on their previous 2009 North Mids. League outings. Jose` Ferriera led the B.A.D.A.C. representatives over the line in fifty ninth place with Dennis Rainbow only just missing out on a place in double figures claiming a hundredth position and Peter Flint completing the counting trio in one hundred and sixty ninth place.
