LINCOLNSHIRE COMBINED EVENTS CHAMPIONSHIPS. Eight Boston and District A.C. representatives claimed places in the top four positions at the end of the two day programme of County Combined Events Championships at the Yarborough Track, Lincoln. Maria Hollingworth secured the Lincs. Silver Award in the Under 15 Girls Pentathlon and Aiden McClure also finished runner up in his multi event contest the Under 17 Octathlon. In the Under 17 Girls Heptathlon Wednesday Pywowariw finished in the Bronze Award position with Alice Flint one place behind. Chelsea Brockett dominated the Senior Girls Heptathlon Championship taking the title with team mate Melanie Bristow the runner up. In the Senior Boys Decathlon Championship Stephan Brockett took the Silver Award with Jake Brittain claiming fourth place at the end of a testing two days and a ten event programme.

Two "Gold Tops" filled the first two positions in the Senior Girls Heptathlon with Chelsea Brockett taking the County Championship title ahead of Melanie Bristow. On her way to a total of 3165 points Chelsea achieved in excess of five hundred in each of three events. Best disciplines for Chelsea were the High jump 1.52m. worth 644 points, 200 metres 28.3 secs. for 589 and 800 metres 2mins. 33.8 secs. to add 646 points. Melanie Bristow accumulated 2250 points with a Javelin throw of 25.96m. contributing 400 points and a 200 metres time of 30.9 secs.for a further 405 points.

In the Under 15 Girls Pentathlon Maria Hollingsworth opened with a swift 12.1secs. for the 75m. Hurdles which earned a very impressive 663 points. A 7.32m. Shot putt added 356 points and a 1.45m. High Jump a further 566 before a leap of 4.01m. in Long Jump contributed another 310 points. In the final discipline the 800 metres Maria recorded 2 mins. 52.6 secs. adding 437 points for a final Pentathlon score of 2332 and runners up position in the County Championship. Becky Locking achieved a points total of 1934 to secure eighth place overall. Her best performance was in the 75m. Hurdles where 12.4 secs. gave her 630 points with a Long Jump of 4.26m. earned a further 369 points.

Two Boston and District A.C. representatives finished in the top four positions in the demanding Senior Boys Decathlon Championship. Stephan Brockett scored 4994 points at the end of the ten disciplines to secure second place in the Championship .In each of six events Stephan acquired over five hundred points: 100 metres 12.1 secs. 586 points, Long Jump 6.01m. 589 , High jump 1.70m. 544 , 400 metres 55.3 secs. 581, Pole Vault 3.80m. 562 and 1500 metres 5 mins. 09.1 sec. 508 points. Team mate Jake Brittain achieved a points total of 4680 for fourth place . In three events the Boston and District A.C. all rounder claimed in excess of five hundred points: High Jump 1.76m. 593 points, 400 metres 56.0 secs. 554 and 1500 metres 4 mins. 57.8 secs. for 572 points.
