

Ninety one runners finished Sunday's Friskney Half Marathon Road Race traditionally a preparatory run for the forthcoming London Marathon with the host club taking the mens team award. Winner of the 2011 Friskney event was Matthew Nutt (Formula One Circuit) who crossed the finish line in 80 mins. 02 secs. almost a full minute ahead of his nearest rival Nelson Wandasiewicz. Third to finish was Matthew Jones (Ripley Running Club) who clocked 81 mins. 40 secs. just fourteen seconds ahead of Jose` Ferriera who was Boston and District Athletic Club's leading runner. Second man home for the "Gold Tops" was fifth placed Dennis Rainbow who recorded 84 mins. 18 secs. for his thirteen plus miles. Third counter for the B.A.D.A.C. team and securing the winning team trophies was the Club's new Mens Track Captain Aidan McClure who recorded 94 mins 12 secs. in nineteenth position. Other representatives of the host club were Timothy Swan-Smith who recorded 98 mins. 06 secs in twenty sixth place with David Johnson thirty seventh in a time of 103 mins. 28 secs. ahead of Tony Tomlin in forty eighth position clocking 110 mins. 52 secs. There was good support for the local club with Darren Auty in fifty sixth place (112mins. 37secs.), Ken Townsend sixty eighth (121 mins. 24 secs) and Bob Shaw eighty fifth (136 mins. 07secs.).

First female to finish the 2011 event was Lucinda Pitcher (Lincoln Wellington) who recorded 90 mins. 48 secs. in thirteenth place with Boston and District A.C. runner Diane Gill crossing the finish line the sixth veteran 45 female in overall sixty seventh position (121 mins. 24 secs.). Bushfield Joggers won the Combined female team awards this year.
