

Peterborough Open Track and Field Meeting. Five young Boston and District Athletic Club members based at The B - Hive the Club's Athletics Training Centre on Punchbowl Lane won five awards at the Peterborough A.C. Open Track and Field meeting at the Embankment Track on Bank Holiday Monday. In the Under 17 Womens 80m Hurdles race Maria Hollingsworth renewed her season long rivalry with Grantham's Millie Cooper. On this occasion Maria was just pipped at the line finishing on 12.0 secs just a tenth of a second behind her close rival. Oliver Smith recorded 23.8 secs in third place in the Under 17 Mens 200 metres and the claimed a further third place medal in the Long Jump with a leap of 5.77m. He also clocked 11.82 secs in fourth position in the 100 metres Final. At Under 15 level Frances Nuttall won the 75 metres Hurdles recording 12.99 secs and went on to clear 1.45m in the High Jump to earn the second place award. In the same age group Lara Smith finished the 100 metres in 14.54 secs and the 200 metres in 30.5 secs. Under 13 Leigh Robertson ran in the combined Under 13/Under 15 1500 metres race recording 5 mins. 16.91 secs in seventh place.
