1. Welcome to Lincolnshire Athletics County Championship 2024

It is Lincolnshire Athletics great pleasure to present our own County Championship Prospectus. It has been a considerable time since we were able to host this event for the County athletes. Lincolnshire Athletics has taken on the challenge to provide this event for 2024. It shall be the first time for several years that it has been hosted by Lincolnshire Athletics. It is envisaged that this pilot event will give us the knowledge and capability to expand the meeting over subsequent years. Lincolnshire Athletics will be presenting an ambitious programme and will be providing hand timing and measurements for this initial meeting. A warm welcome is extended to all athletes and spectators.

Lincolnshire Athletics expresses gratitude to all the Officials who are supporting this event, without whom this would not have been possible.

2. Eligibility to Compete

Athletes are eligible either by virtue of birth or residence in Lincolnshire. Some athletes will have a dual qualification i.e. born in one County living in the other – these athletes must choose which County they wish to compete in, or for. They must stay with the same county each calendar year so if they entered Cross Country Championships of either County in 2023/2024 XC season they have made their choice for this year.

6. Data Protection

7. Starting heights and Number of trials

In all Field events except HJ and PV competitors will have four trials and if they achieve AAA Grade III standard in one of those trials they will be entitled to a further 2 trials. In the case of Masters/Veterans, who will throw the weights appropriate to their age, achieving the corresponding Masters standard in the first four rounds, shall determine whether two further trials are awarded. Similarly achieving Masters Standards in the first four rounds of horizontal jumps will determine whether 2 further trials are allowed.

Opening heights U13 Girls HJ will open at 1.15 m; U13 Boys HJ at 1.20 m- the bar rising in 5 cm increments. PV will start at 1.70 m rising in 10 cm increments. U11 Long Jump will be 3 Jumps Only.

Athletes may use their own implements if the equipment has been presented to the Field Referee for weighing at least 1 hour prior to the event in which the equipment shall be used.

8. Entry fees:

Meeting Fee = $\pounds 5$ U17 and older an additional $\pounds 3$ per event I.E. 1 event is $\pounds 5+\pounds 3 = \pounds 8$

Juniors (U15 and Under) Meeting Fee plus £2 per event I.E. 1 event is £5+£2 = £7

Please note the number of events an athlete in each age group may compete in is as below. U11 -3 events *UKA rules to be applied* U13s and U15s and U17s can only do 3 events U13s can only compete in one event between 600m and 1500m U15s can only compete in one event between 600m to 3000m
