Beryl's report:

Nineteen members contested the Club Quadrathlon Competitions held on Friday evening (June 6th). There were some very competitive age group competitions with a number of really promising individual performances. Olli Tiainen won the Senior/Veteran Mens event with 306 points. Ollie's best scoring event was the Long Jump where a leap of 5.24m. earned him 86 points. In second place Ben Pell recorded 12.8 secs. for 100 Metres for 85 points and Oli Lammiman (third) harvested 84 points from his final event the 800 Metres run in 2 mins.21.5 secs.. In the Under 17 Mens competition Edward Roffe scored most points in the 100 Metres when he recorded 12.7 secs. and at Under 20 level Jess Newlin scored over forty points in all four of her events. The Under 15 Boys competition was closely contested with James Dunn on a total of 253 points just edging out Harry Jackson who finished with 249 points. James clinched victory in the final event recording 2 min. 23.8 secs. in the 800 Metres after he had scored over 50 points in his first three Quadrathlon contests-- (100m 13.6 secs. 60 points, Shot 7.51m. 59 points Long Jump 4.04m. 52 points). Harry accumulated 78 points in two of his events recording 12.7 secs in the 100 Metres and 2 mins 27.0 secs in the 800 Metres. Lexi Mindham was first in the Under 15 Girls age group achieving 198 points with her 4.30m. leap in Long Jump the most productive event contributing 61 points. Isabel Cassell finished with a total of 126 points and for her best individual result recorded 3.95m. in Long Jump for 50 points. Under 13 Rose Pell cleared 4.23m. in Long Jump (59 points) and recorded 14.3 secs. for 100 Metres (46 points) on her way to a Quadrathlon score of 148 points. The Under 11 Boys Quadrathlon was won by Toby Nicholson who amassed 238 points. Toby's Vortex throw measuring 21.75m. earned him 69 points with a time of 11.6 secs. recorded for 75 m Sprint adding a further 66 points. Second placed George Walters gained 59 points from both 75 Metres 12.3 secs. and Vortex 16.42 m. and finished with a total of 217 points. In the same age group John Maycock was third with 196 points after opening with a 59 point contribution through a 12.3 secs time in the 75 Metres. In the youngest age category Tajus Lubys on 229 points had a clear victory. Tajus harvested over sixty points from two events when 12.1 secs in the 75 Metres gave him 61 points and a Vortex throw of 21.33m. added a further 69 to his total. Millie Penson's 75m. Sprint 17.0 secs and her 6.54m throw in Vortex were her most productive events. Harry Holstead, Joseph Collier and Michael Dunn were unable to complete the full four Quadrathlon events after making promising starts to their programme.
