Vet categories are V40, V50 and V60.

To be eligible for awards you will need to possess a county qualification by birth or residence. Guest runners (non Lincolnshire and unaffiliated) permitted but not eligible for awards.

Club vests must be worn.

The first 5 finishers (U13, U15, U17, U20) and first 3 seniors in the county champs are eligible to represent Lincolnshire in the inter-county champs (CAUs) should we send teams - and get to wear a county vest.

Athletes are required to read this statement from UKA

'An entrant shall be deemed to have made him/herself/their self, familiar with, and agreed to be bound by the UKA Anti-Doping Rules and to submit to the authority of UK Anti-Doping in the application and enforcement of the Anti-Doping Rules. The UKA Anti-Doping Rules apply to entrants participating in the sport of Athletics, for 12 months from the [date of entry], whether or not the licence holder is a citizen of, or resident in, the UK.'

Entering the County Championships will be taken as acceptance of the above statement.
