

Congratulations to the eight members of the Club who represented Lincolnshire in the East Midlands Regional Sportshall Athletics Championships at Grantham Meres Sports Centre on Sunday. The young "Gold Tops" competed against representative teams from Nottinghamshire, Derbyshire and Leicestershire and Rutland. In the Under 15 Girls Allrounder Competition Lexi Mindham was the highest placed Lincolnshire representative and finished in joint tenth position with a points total of 121. In individual events Lexi was a very good third in the Two Laps recording 24.4 secs. and in the third of her three Shot trials she reached 7.37m. to claim fifth place. In the third of her three individual events Lexi cleared 1.96m. in Standing Long Jump to gain ninth place points. In the same age group Macey Hammersley accumulated 101 points for twenty first place overall. Macey's best result was in Speed Bounce when her score of 73 earned her sixth position and she also recorded 26.0 secs. in the Two Laps for joint tenth place and 45cms. in Vertical Jump for twelfth position. In the final analysis the Lincolnshire Under 15 Boys team was third in the Championship. Caleb Cowley made significant contribution and finished second of the Lincs team members with an overall total of 118 points. Caleb was fifth in the Two Lap event recording 22.9 secs. (40 points), sixth in the Standing Triple Jump with a leap of 7.04m. (40 points) and eighth in Shot with a best putt of 8.61m. (36 points) for a really good County team debut. In the Under 13 Girls section Rose Pell achieved a splendid third place in Standing Long Jump with a leap of 2.08m which earned an excellent 24 points. Rose was also equal seventh in the Two Laps and contributed to the Lincs. team result as a relay team member. Emily Ward was a good equal fifth in Speed Bounce recording a total of 75 and also claimed equal seventh in the Two Laps as well as contributing to the team relay efforts. Making her Lincs. debut Aurelia Barrett cleared [1.58m.in](#) Standing Long Jump for eighth position. Boston and District A.C. had two representatives at Under 11 level. John Maycock had a fine Speed Bounce competition finishing in an excellent equal third position with a score of 50 which was just one bound less than the winner's score. John was also eleventh in the Standing Triple Jump with a clearance of 4.39 m.. In the Under 11 Girls Standing Long Jump Connie Waterson cleared a good 1.88m. to claim a fine fourth place and also recorded 48 secs, in the Balance Test for eighth position. All our representatives produced good efforts for Lincolnshire in a range of team and group relay contests and represented both themselves and the Club with great credit. Well done.
