U18 / U20 / Sen Men /Women
100m 200m 400m 800m 1500m 110mH(m) 100mH (w) 3000m Long Jump Shot

Composite Relay will be run as follows;

One Race comprising teams from the U12, U14 and U16 age groups

It will be a mixed gender race and teams must have at least two of both genders in them. The composition of the Teams and what they will run is as follows;

U12 4 x 100 U14 2 x 200 U16 2 x 400m

Relay entries will be taken on the day.

Medals to first 3 in each event

Field events – U10 & U12 three trials only and for U14 U16 U18 & U20 and Senior a further three trials for the Top Six in each of those age groups.

Relays £4.00 per team. Enter on the day.. Mixed gender teams of the same age group,

ENTRY FEES First event £7.00 then subsequent events £5.00 each. The maximum number of events which may be entered by athletes under and including the U16 age group is three,

No athlete U16 may compete in more than one event of a distance over 400m on the same day.

'An entrant shall be deemed to have made him/herself/their self, familiar with, and agreed to be bound by the UKA Anti-Doping Rules and to submit to the authority of UK Anti-Doping in the application and enforcement of the Anti-Doping Rules. The UKA Anti-Doping Rules apply to entrants participating in the sport of Athletics, for 12 months from the [date of entry], whether or not the licence holder is a citizen of, or resident in, the UK.'
